



Supplementary Regulations: Bridgetown Brass Monkey

Date: 19 & 20 July 2025

Location: Blackwood River - Bridgetown

Event Type: Race

Craft: Mini Jet ONLY

Director: Matt Cadd

Sweep: TBA on the Day

Entry: Online/EFT or Cash

Price: \$60 Per Craft

- This is a BANK LAUNCH – You will need a 4x4 vehicle
- Compulsory event and safety brief will be at 0900 at the campground Saturday 19th
- Day two brief will be at 0900 at the campground Sunday 20th
- There shall be 2 competitors in each craft and each entered craft shall have a support crew of not less than one adult.
- Each competitor must be a current financial member and carry the appropriate MJWA licence and have craft insurance paid in full
- Course is as per Map and subject to change pending water levels on the day
- Checkpoints will be manned in nominated locations on the day
- Support crew communication by mobile phone or UHF radio
- GPS tracking will be used for safety, RockBros M1 or approved ONLY
- A disqualification speed of 67km/hr will apply
- Vessel scrutineering will take place prior entry to the water both days
- Pit area will adjacent to the entry ramp
- No fuelling of craft within 50m of the water way
- This event does contribute race points to the season
- Camping is permitted – respect the area and leave it as you found it or better
- Support crews must be entered on the entry form
- Emergency procedures as per event approvals and contact details in event folder
- Each craft and occupants shall present fully compliant with the current rules and regulations of MJWA and be carrying all river safety equipment
- Members submitting the official race entry form for the event assume, by way of entry, that the event is potentially dangerous.

This event may be run backwards on the day if water levels permit a safe passage up river. The Race Director will advise on the day. This event is also extended beyond Bridgetown Bridge if water permits.

Spectator viewing areas are a minimum 10M from the waters edge at all locations along the event route, access to the water closer than this at your own risk, you have been warned
